<p>English: In English, we will focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Writing a short adventure story. • How to structure a letter. • Learning about how to write a play script from a fiction text. • Exploring techniques used to enhance the performance of different texts. • Continuing to develop our understanding of grammar and its uses in our writing. <p>Parents please would you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Read every day with your child and write a comment in their reading record. ▪ Please ensure that your children have learnt the spellings for their weekly spelling test and know the meanings of the words. ▪ Allow your child to use Doodle English for 10-15 minutes daily. 	<p>Maths: In maths we will focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Deepening our understanding of numbers and place value. ▪ Our mental arithmetic - adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers mentally. ▪ Deepening our understanding of area and perimeter of shapes. ▪ Measuring different angles and using appropriate tools. ▪ Developing our knowledge of 2D shapes. <p>Parents please would you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Ensure your children know all of the times tables to 12 with immediate recall of the number facts. ▪ Allow your child to use Doodle Maths for 10-15 minutes daily. 	<p>Science: Focus- Materials and their properties. We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Discuss and group the different properties of materials. ▪ Investigate and expand our knowledge of which materials are insulators or conductors of heat and electricity. ▪ Investigate ways in which different mixtures can be separated. ▪ Investigate reversible and irreversible chemical changes to materials. ▪ Use our previous knowledge of solids, liquids and gases. <p>Parents please would you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Discuss the different everyday materials and how they are used, with your children. 	<p>Computing: We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning how to use audio editing software. • Recording and editing a song and poem. • Using technology and computer software to aid our learning about our topic. <p>Parents please would you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Discuss the importance of staying safe online. ▪ Discuss how the technology of listening to music has changed throughout your lifetime.
