Dear Parents/Carers,
On Thursday, we will be holding an Easter Triduum service with the children in school, then it will be party day. The children can wear their own clothes for the day and will have games and Golden Time in the afternoon.

We are finishing school early on Friday:-

Nursery/Reception classes - 1.45 pm
Years 1 and $2 \quad 1.50 \mathrm{pm}$
Years 3 and $4 \quad 1.55$ pm
Year 5 and $6 \quad 2.00$ pm
Please take note of these times. There will be no After School Care on Friday.
When we return to school after Easter, Monday $25^{\text {th }}$ April is an INSET day and the children will return on Tuesday, $26^{\text {th }}$ April.

The school gates will open at 8.45 for the parents to bring their children into the playground. For Nursery and Reception parents, you too can come at that time, but you must stay with your children until the bell rings at 9.00am, when you can take your children to the Foundation Unit gate. From there the staff will take the children inside. You will also pick your children up from that gate at 3.30.

Parents of children from Years 1-6, you can leave your children in the playground if you wish at 8.45 or you can stay until the bell rings. All of the teachers are in the playground from 8.45 and this is often a good opportunity to talk to them. However, please do not try and talk to teachers at 9.00 as they have to get inside and take registers. The gates open at 3.25 for you to come into the playground and wait for your children and all classes will now finish at 3.30.

Parents can now also come into the reception area to buy uniform, book bags, etc. And parents conferences will be in person, at long last!

May $2^{\text {nd }}$ is a bank holiday and school is closed.
May $5^{\text {th }}$ is Polling day and school is closed for the children.
May $30^{\text {th }}$ - June $3^{\text {rd }}$ is half-term week.
Have a wonderful Easter - we can all pray for good weather. I am really looking forward to seeing you all in the playground and not the street!
